



PACKAGES: Safari Kenya!

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Package 1: LAKE NAKURU – LAKE NAIVASHA – MASAI MARA (7 days, 6 nights)

Day 1: Nairobi

>>Arrive at the Jomo Kenyatta International Airport, meet and greet by representative of Salama tours and transfer to the Panafric Hotel or similar one, booked on bed and breakfast. After short rest transfer for a visit to Karen Blixien museum, the historical home of Danish author who was focus of 1985 movie out of Africa. Lunch at Karen coffee garden, transfer to the Pan-Afrique Hotel.

Day 2: Lake Nakuru

>>After breakfast, depart for Lake Nakuru national park arriving in good time for lunch at lion hill lodge. Afternoon game drive in the park and around this Lake that is famous for large concentration of pink flamingos and other bird life. You will have the golden opportunities to take attractive pictures of myriads of pink bodies gliding above the reflection of blue water. The lake is also considered to be the first rhino sanctuary for the black and white species rhino. Other animals that are common in the area including reedbuck, bushbuck, warthog, leopard, baboon and giraffe. Dinner and overnight stay at the Sarova lion hill lodge.

Day3: Lake Naivasha

>>Pre- breakfast game drive and after breakfast depart for Lake Naivasha arriving in good time for lunch at the Naivasha Sopa lodge. Lake Naivasha is unusual Lake, not having any outlet which is normally a prerequisite for fresh water lakes. The Lake edge has dense vegetation which in turn support a thriving bird population including the grey-capped warbler, spectacled weaver, brimstone canary and red-billed 350 species of birds in the area. Afternoon visit to Hells gate located just beyond Lake Naivasha. It's a paradise for ornithologists Hells gate are breeding grounds for vulture, verreaux eagles, augur buzzard and thousands of swifts; 103 species of bird have been recorded in the park. Special locations to view include Fischer tower formerly a volcano plug, the central tower and Njorowa Gorges. Natural steam vents rise from fissures in the volcanic rock. Dinner and overnight at the Naivasha Sopa lodge.

Day4, 5 and 6: Masai Mara

>>After breakfast depart to the famous Masai Mara game reserve driving through the spectacular Great Rift valley via Narok town, the major Masai administration centre. Masai Mara is considered to be one of Kenya most precious wild life sanctuaries, this be game rivers as one of Africa greatest concentration of wild animals. Plain game can be found here in staggering numbers which in turn support a tremendous predator population. We will have the opportunity to see wildebeest, herds of buffaloes, lions, impalas, giraffes, elephants, topi, warthog, ostriches, cheetahs, hyenas and many other kind of wild life. You may opt for a visit to Masai village or walking safari at an extra cost. All meals and overnight Sarova luxury Tented Camp.

Day 7: Nairobi via Rift Valley

>>After breakfast depart for Nairobi. Drive through the spectacular great Rift Valley via Narok town arriving in Nairobi and check in at the Panafric Hotel. Lunch at on this day is not included later, we continue for dinner to the Carnivore Restaurant. After wards transfer to the Airport for your flight home.

Package 2: SAMBURU - SHABA GAME RESERVE – LAKE NAKURU – LAKE NAIVASHA – MASAI MARA (9 days, 8 nights)

Day 1: Nairobi

>>Arrive at the Jomo Kenyata International Airport, meet and greet by representative of Salama tours and transfer to the Panafric Hotel or similar one, booked on bed and break fast. After short rest transfer for a visit to Karen Blixien museum, the historical home of Danish author who was focus of 1985 movie out of Africa. Lunch at Karen coffee garden, transfer to the Panafric Hotel.

Day 2 and 3: Samburu Game Reserve

>>After breakfast depart for Northern Kenya to Samburu where you will passing through the equator arriving in good time for lunch at the Sarova shaba lodge. Samburu is same arid open Savannah plain broken by a small rugged hills in Kenya Norhtern Province situated on the banks Ewaso Nyiro River with it is crocodile and leopards. The nature in Samburu is renowned for a range of rare game, including the elusive leopards, lions, elephants, the long necked gerenuk, grevys zebra, reticulated giraffe,beisa oryx, and so many others. Game drives in afternoon of day 2 and morning and afternoon of day 3. Dinner and overnight stay at the Sarova Shaba lodge for both days.

Day 4: Lake Nakuru

>>After breakfast dapart for Lake Nakuru national park arriving in good time for lunch at lion hill lodge. Afternoon game drive in the park and around this Lake that is famous for large concentration of pink Hamingoes and other bird life. You will have the golden opportunities to take attractive pictures of myriads of pink bodies gliding above the reflection of blue water. The lake is also considered to be the first rhino sanctuary for the black and white species rhino. Other animals that are common in the area including reedbuck, bushbuck, warthog, leopard, baboon and giraffe. Dinner and overnight stay at the Sarova lion hill lodge.

Day 5: Lake Naivasha

>>Pre- breakfast game drive and after breakfast depart for Lake Naivasha arriving in good time for lunch at the Naivasha Sopa lodge.
